## Kildare Campus

### A Vision Realised

In 2020, our College secured 80 acres of land at 194 Mt Terrick Road to meet increasing demand from our community and to shape the future of education at St Joseph's College.

The turning of the sod took place in November 2021, and in July 2023 we welcomed our first Year 7 students to Kildare Campus. From 2025 onwards, the campus encompasses Years 7, 8 and 9.

### Designed with Purpose

Kildare Campus architecture beautifully reflects the bond between tradition and innovation. The Brigidine charism is woven into the design through the symbolism of St Brigid's Cross, graceful archways and the propagation of our historic oak tree.

Natural timber finishes, soaring ceilings and expansive windows create calm, light-filled learning environments. The seasonal colour palette and indoor-outdoor connection nurture wellbeing and belonging. Sustainability is central to the design, featuring solar panels, power-saving climate control, automated lighting systems and self-sustaining irrigation from the onsite dam.

### Built For Contemporary Learning

The open-plan design fosters collaboration and flexibility, with standing desks, breakout spaces and quiet zones supporting diverse learning styles.

### Exceptional Outdoor & Sporting Facilities

- AFL-standard football oval with lights
- Soccer pitch
- Two covered state-of-the-art basketball/netball courts
- Outdoor exercise equipment
- Softfall sports area
- Landscaped green spaces
- Ample parking

#### Coming for 2027

- Six-lane running/athletics track
- Two tennis courts

### Stage 3 Expansion (Commenced November 2025)

- Multi-Function Centre (MFC)
- Two full-sized indoor courts
- Retractable seating for 800 (total seating capacity 1800)
- Performance stage
- 250-seat Theatre
- Dedicated dance, drama and music spaces
- Foyer, kiosk and full amenities
- Expansion of the Hayden Building (General Learning Area)

These additions will provide exceptional opportunities in sport, performance, arts and community gatherings.
